

Appeal against the decisions of the Access Panel

Please read the following information carefully

- Grounds for Appeal may include:
- The Access Panel:
 - o failed to consider the application
 - o did not take into account the supporting evidence
 - o failed to apply published AQE policy and guidelines
 - were not consistent and fair in the application of the AQE published Policy and
 Guidelines to all requests for Access Arrangements

An appeal application must not:

 Include additional information which was not available to the Access Panel at the time of the decision*

An appeal application **must** provide the following:

- An Appeal Application Form (available on page 2 of this document)
- Reasonable grounds to convene an Access Appeals Panel
- A case (with supporting rationale), that the Access Panel did not hear the application, or did not
 apply the relevant published AQE policy or guidelines

^{*}If you have additional information which was not available to the Access Panel at the time of the decision and you now wish to submit this, please use the 'Late Additional Information' form rather than the Appeals form.
